

## **Town of Frankfort**

### **Monthly Board Meeting – February 10, 2026**

Meeting convened at 6:34 pm. Present were Supervisors Josh Manor, Kurt Manore and Chris Jensen, Town Chairman Brad Anderson. Debra Fisher, Clerk and Jill Anderson, Treasurer were also present. Citizens attending the meeting were Cindy Lane and Sally Farrar. No attendees on Zoom platform.

The January meeting minutes were accepted as submitted.

The Financial report was accepted as submitted.

Citizen's concerns: Cindy Lane brought information about Ridge Breeze Dairy's request for a permit from the DNR to spread manure on 600 acre located in the Town of Frankfort. The biggest concern is protecting the road from damage during hauling of manure.

The town zoning chair received a phone call from Darren Miexner with questions about building a campground on Double SS. Both items will likely be looked at during the upcoming Planning Commission meeting on Thursday, February 19<sup>th</sup> at 6:30 pm

Brad Anderson attended the quarterly Fire District Meeting. There is still much paperwork that needs to be done to complete the process of forming the Durand Fire District. The annual meeting will be in April.

Board of Review training is (March 7). Debra Fisher has signed up and will be attending BOR training for the Town. A workshop by UW Extension on AI in local government is scheduled for (March 18)

Road reports-had a mishap with a stop sign at cutoff road. It has been reported and repaired. Small grant program deadline is May 1<sup>st</sup> and the 6/20 report shows that the Town may have up to 6 culver/bridges that are in need of repair or replacement. Beaver Slide and Paradise roads were also mentioned.

Cemetery report: Resolution 2026-1 the resolution to take over maintenance of the Porcupine Cemetery was approved. Sam Kaempf has signed and delivered the letter of intent. The last piece will be accepting all Porcupine Cemetery records and accounting. Caretaker will send an email to Mrs. Kaempf this week requesting records. Then make an appointment with the bank to have town officials (Chairman, Treasurer, Caretaker) as signers on Porcupine Cemetery accounts.

Bills were approved.
