AMENDING CODE OF ORDINANCES CHAPTER 12/ORDINANCE NO. 2018-1, ENTITLED TOWN OF FRANKFORT CEMETERY ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE TOWN OF FRANKFORT, PEPIN COUNTY:

Section 1. Authority and Purpose. This Ordinance is enacted under Sections 60.22 and 157.50 of the Wisconsin Statutes.

Section 2. That the Town Cemeteries Chapter 12 of the Code of Ordinances for the Town of Frankfort, County of Pepin be amended by amending the following Sections:

SECTION 12.105 TOWN OWNED AND OPERATED CEMETERY

12.105 – TOWN OF FRANKFORT OWNED AND OPERATED CEMETERY

The Town of Frankfort shall provide the management, control, operation, and maintenance for the Town of Frankfort currently owned cemetery "Little Plum Cemetery".

- A. Lot and Lot sales. The Town Board shall from time to time by resolution fix a price on all lots to be sold for burials in any town cemetery. Lots shall be purchased from the Town Clerk. No lot shall be used for any other purpose than the burial of human remains. Maintenance of accurate sales and lot location will be kept by the Town Clerk.
- B. Number of graves per lot. No lot at any town cemetery may be used for the burial of more than one body except in the following circumstances:
 - Two remains from cremation shall be allowed in one lot with one headstone or two flat markers to be placed only in line with other stones.
 - 2. One full body and one remains from cremation shall be allowed in one lot, with one headstone or two flat markers to be placed only in line with other stones.
 - 1. One full body and up to four remains from cremation per plot may be laid to rest in a TRADITIONAL or GREEN burial.
- C. Conveyance of Lots. All lots sold in the cemetery shall be conveyed by deed or receipt. The transfer of deeded lots to another party must be reported in writing to the Town Clerk.

D. Perpetual Care. Perpetual care is limited to the maintenance of lawn, leaf disposal, filling sunken graves, raising markers, and caring for avenues, alleys, fences, buildings and grounds in general.

D. Investments and Improvements. The Town assumes to use the net annual income received from sales of cemetery lots, fees for perpetual care for lots and interest income from the cemetery fund to provide for perpetual care.

Per WI Stat 157.50(5), the electors at the Annual Town Meeting may authorize the Town Board to appropriate up to \$500 per year for improvements. This is not a limitation on the Town Board, which may spend money on Town cemeteries on its own accord.
