## Town of Frankfort Plan Commission Public Hearing Conditional Use Permit - Kasey Kolve Gun Shop/Gunsmithing August 3, 2023 Minutes

Commission Chair Don Gisch called the hearing to order at 6:30 p.m. Remote attendance for this meeting was an option.
